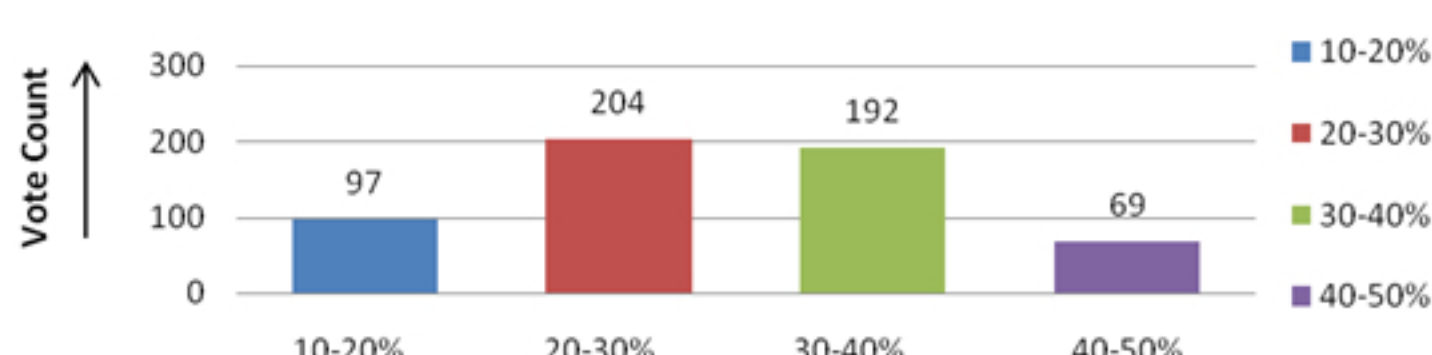

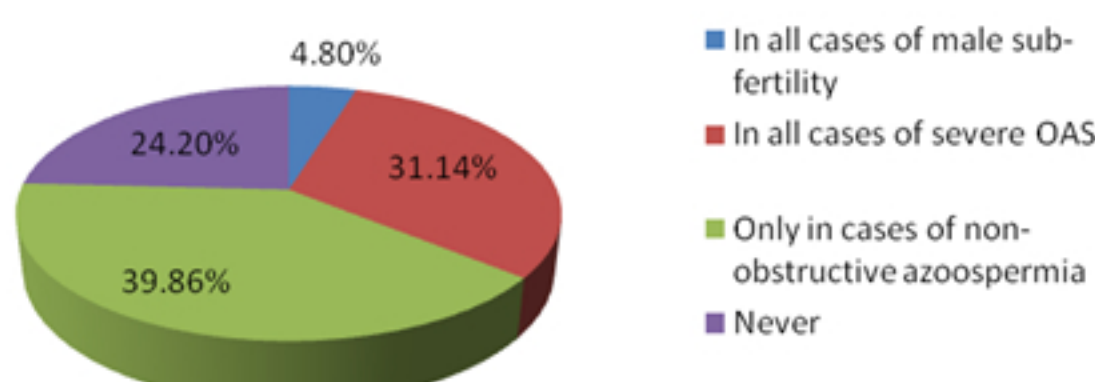

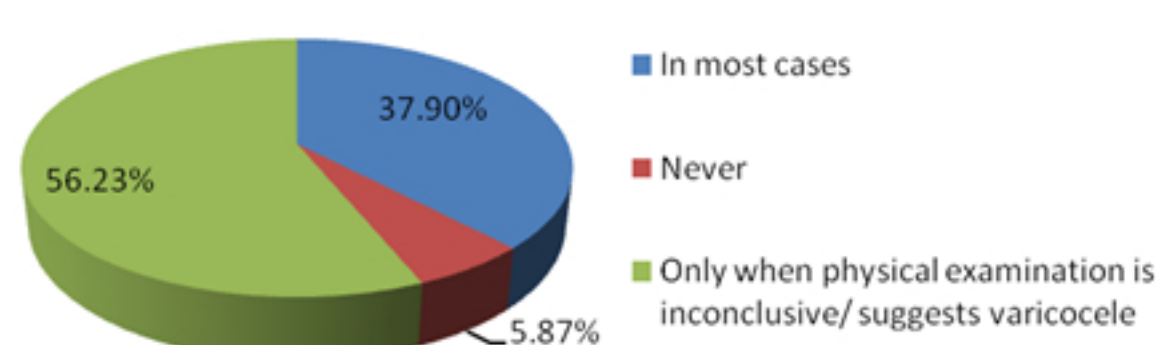
Q1) What is the incidence of male infertility in your clinic?



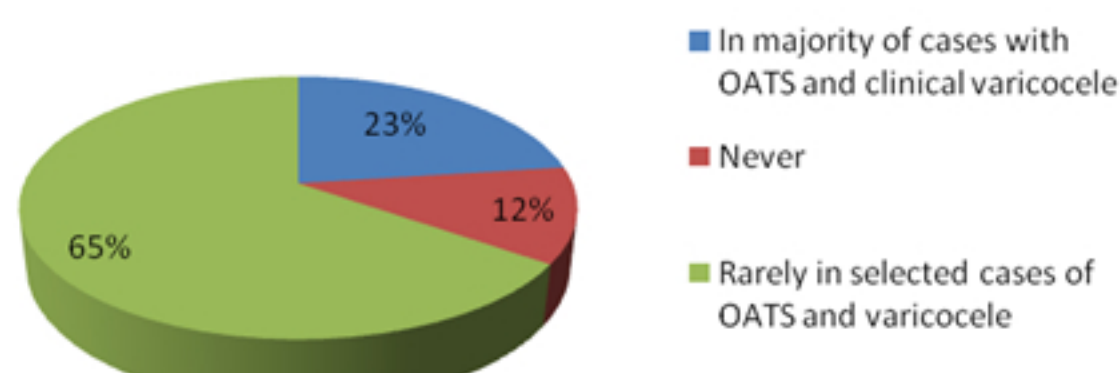
Q2) Do you do genetic testing in patients with male infertility?



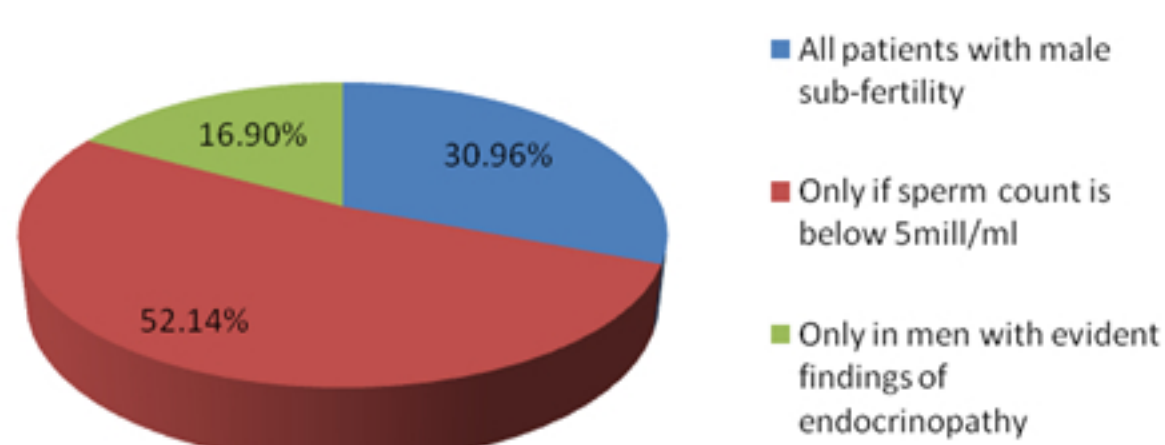
Q3) Do you advise for scrotal Ultrasound in patients with male infertility?



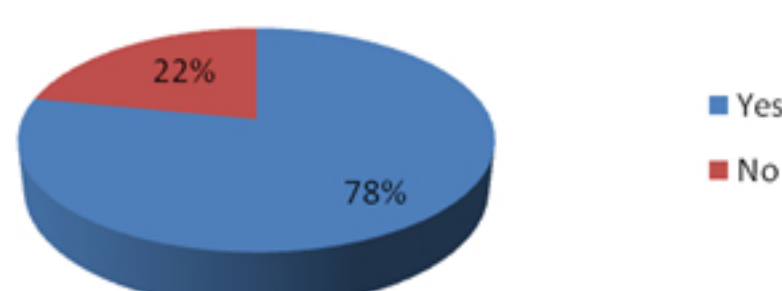
Q4) Do you advise varicocele surgery?



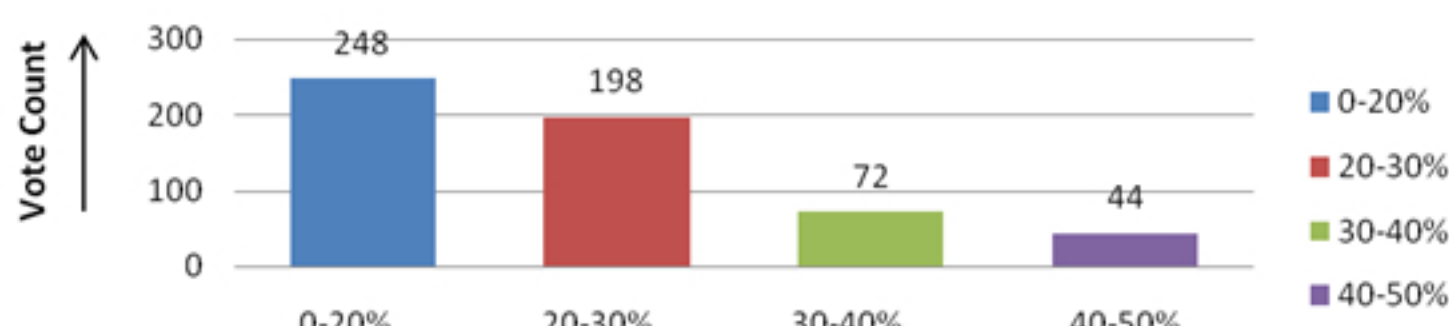
Q5) Do you do hormonal evaluation in men with male infertility?



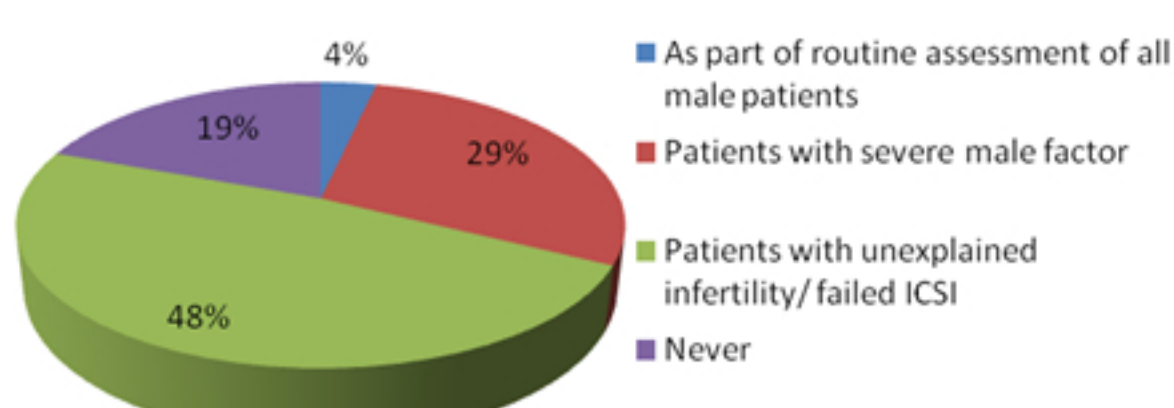
Q6) Do you advise empirical medical therapy?



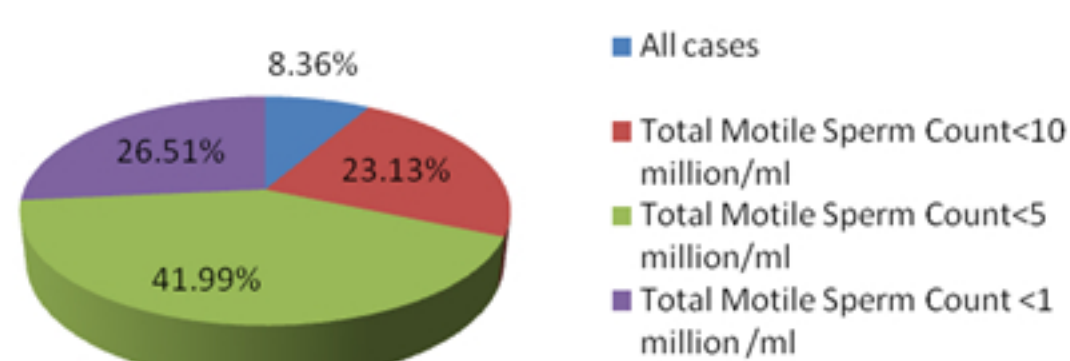
Q7) What percentage of patients in your clinic is benefited after medical therapy?



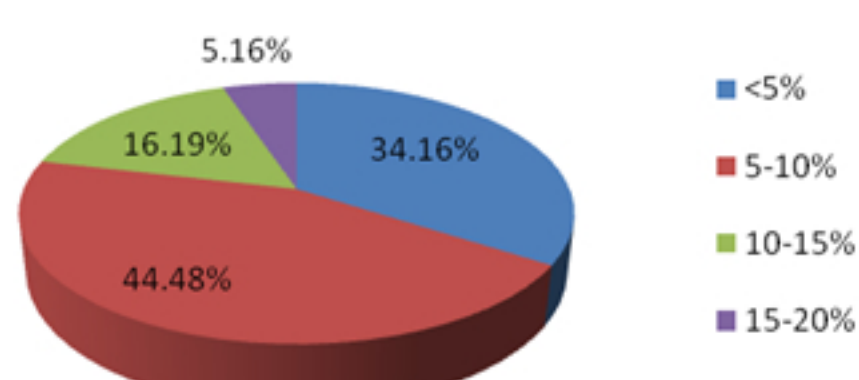
Q8) When do you do sperm DNA fragmentation Index?



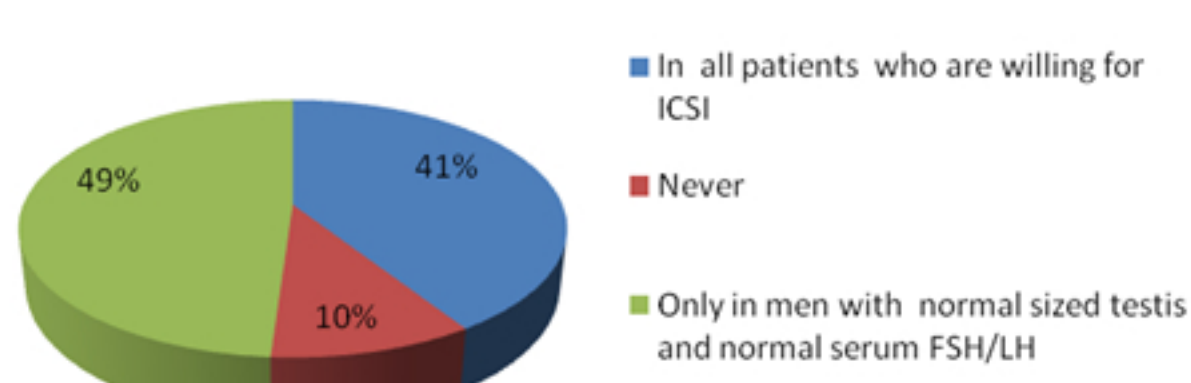

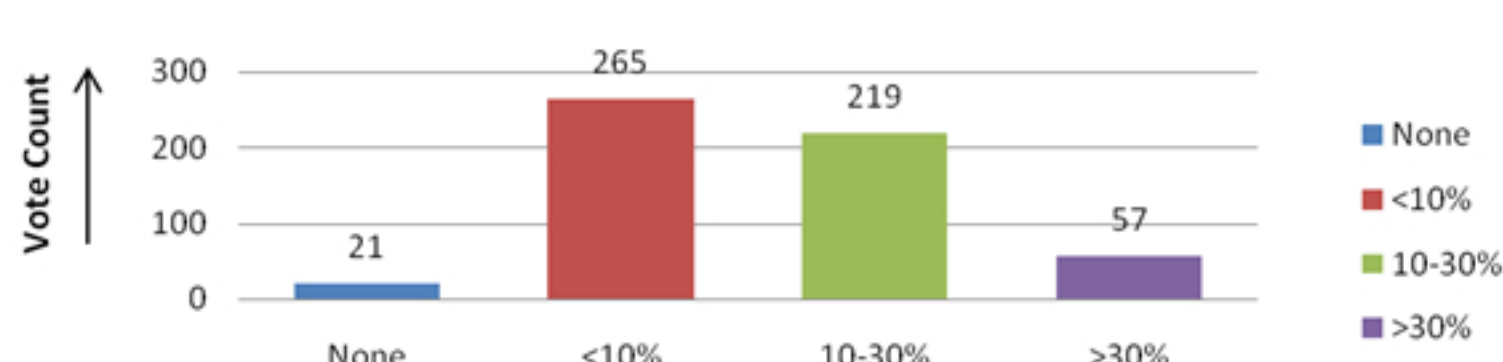
