But what about the baby? Fetal Origin of Adult Diseases As a result of advances in technology and provision of services, an increasing number of infants are born as a result of Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) Therapy. In developed countries, ART pregnancies represent 1.7% to 4.0% of all births. A "good perinatal outcome" among live births after ART is defined as the live birth of a singleton infant born at term (≥ 37 Completed weeks of gestation) and at a normal birth weight (of  $\geq$  2500 g). However, concern is mounting over the safety of ART and it's effect on maternal and fetal wellbeing. It is well documented that ART pregnancies have a significantly higher risk of multiple pregnancy and adverse perinatal outcomes, including preterm delivery, low birth weight and birth defects. Some studies have suggested an increased risk of preeclampsia, gestational hypertension, placenta previa and gestational diabetes in ART pregnancies.
